

Malts & Gins List



Malts

Island & Islay Whisky

- Arbeg 10 yo** 25ml £6.00
Very peaty, smoky and complex yet it does not flaunt the peat; rather it gives way to natural sweetness to produce a whisky of perfect balance.
- Bowmore 12 yo** £5.50
Complex and subtle with delicious smoky notes and hints of toffee.
- Bruichladdich Classic Laddie** £6.00
Clean, fresh and lively with sweet oak and barley in perfect harmony.
- Caol Ila 12 yo** £6.90
Packing plenty of potent phenols, this is a refined, powerful dram with a compensating oiliness. A balanced, peaty beauty.
- Highland Park 12 yo** £4.90
This classic malt combines island characteristics with Speyside flavours. Smooth and subtle with rich, well-balanced, malty tones and soft smoke.
- Isle of Jura 10 yo** £4.90
Light peat and diesel oil on the nose. Relatively light with hints of sweet citrus, ending on a dry, nutty finish.
- Talisker 10 yo** £6.00
A very individual Island malt with an enticing smoky nose and an explosive, smoky-peppery palate that echoes through the finish.

Lowland Whisky

- Auchentoshan American Oak** 25ml £5.00
Tempting aromas of toasted almonds and caramelised toffee are followed by the signature smooth, delicate, Auchentoshan taste.
- Glenkinchie 12 yo** £5.70
Fragrant aromas with gentle hints of honey. The palate is fruity with a slight hint of Calvados and smoky oak.

Highland Whisky

- Clynelish 14 yo** 25ml £7.10
Rather peaty with a sea freshness. Fruity and spicy with malted barley and floral hints.
- Dalmore 12 yo** £7.10
Aged in sherry casks, it has a powerful nose and is very smooth. Spicy marmalade and heather smoke notes persist into an orange finish. The pride of Whyte and Mackay.
- Dalmore 15 yo** £11.00
A truly delicious malt; elegant and refined with aromas of dried spice, cloves, cinnamon and ginger combined with hints of Seville oranges.
- Dalwhinnie 15 yo** £6.10
Awarded 95 points by Jim Murray in his Whisky Bible, this is a simple, flawless, clean and crisp malt. Enjoy aromas of heather and a light, subtly peaty nose.
- Glenmorangie 10 yo** £5.50
Floral with citrus notes and balanced traces of almond and smoky spices.
- Old Pulteney 12 yo** £5.10
Crisp and clean with great balance revealing notes of herbs with medium body and musty flavours leading into an oaky finish.
- Tomatin 12 yo** £5.20
Medium-bodied, well-balanced and quite sweet. There are notes of fudge and dark sugar, winter spice and a touch of vinosity.

Highland Whisky cont.

- Tomatin 14 yo** 25ml £7.50
Quite a powerful nose. Big bunches of red berries and grapes. Vanilla, oak and hints of white pepper. Fruity on the finish.
- Tomatin 18 yo** £12.50
Grape-like nose with hints of exotic spices, custard and cider. Toffee apples and beeswax, cedar, white chocolate and nutmeg. Warming. A good finish with hints of oak and potpourri.
- Tomatin Legacy** £4.60
Sweet aromas of lemon and pine with delightful notes of cracked pepper, sweet barley and warming oak on the mouth.

Speyside Whisky

- Aberlour 12 yo** 25ml £6.10
This double matured version is a mix of traditional oak and sherry casks and is rich and fruity with delicious Christmas cake notes.
- Balvenie 12 yo** £6.00
Deep amber in colour. Re-racked in oloroso sherry casks to give a sherry nose with a nutty, malty finish.
- Balvenie 14 yo** £7.90
Matured for fourteen years in traditional oak casks before being transferred to Caribbean Rum casks to create a well-rounded and drinkable Whisky with notes of fruit and vanilla.
- Cragganmore 12 yo** £5.90
A rich, slightly floral whisky with barley notes on the nose. A strong, malty taste with hints of sweet wood smoke and sandalwood followed by a long, malt-driven finish with light smoke and hints of sweetness.
- Glenfarclas 10 yo** £5.10
Home to an independent family since 1865 in the valley of the green grass, this is a firm, slightly smoky malt. Dry at first and then blossoming into a sweet, long finish.
- Glenfiddich 12 yo** £4.90
Sweet, fruity notes and hints of pears on the nose leading into creamy, subtle oak flavours in its aromatic flavour. Rounded off with a long, and mellow finish.
- Glenfiddich Solera 15 yo** £6.50
This medium-bodied malt supports the Christmas pudding flavours - sherry, raisins, fruitcake, spices and sweetness - preceding an oaky finish.
- Glenlivet Founder's Reserve** £5.10
Full gold in colour, the nose is mellow and sophisticated, backed by a sweet, biscuity note with a remote and elusive fragrance that becomes more floral at reduced strength.
- Glenlivet 12 yo** £5.10
A great example of the character of Glenlivet's whisky, boasting a bounty of orchard fruit, fragrant florals and honeyed malt notes carried on a creamy mouth feel.
- Glenlivet Caribbean Reserve** £5.10
The palate is fruity with mandarin orange and fresh melon notes playing off of a baseline of toffee and mint. The finish is very smooth with a lingering sweetness.
- Glanallachie** £5.50
This features whisky matured in Pedro Ximénez, Oloroso and virgin oak casks, resulting in a huge flavour profile of fruit, oak and vanilla.
- Tamnavulin** £4.60
Rich, warm aromas of apple, toffee and honey with sweet marzipan and subtle tangy marmalade notes. Fresh, mellow with pear creamy peaches and pineapple and a hint of Demerara sugar. Rich, smooth and refreshing.
